

Peak Performance launches psychometric driving test

Driver training firm Peak Performance has linked with Cranfield University to launch a new driver risk assessment using psychometric techniques.

Fleet Driver Risk Index is based on 20 years of research into driver behaviour and predicts how

drivers are likely to perform behind the wheel, with specific applications for corporate, public sector and emergency service fleets.

The on-line assessment costs up to £25 per driver, and measures 12 behaviour factors as well as factoring in elements such as age,

experience and previous accidents.

Fleet managers receive an executive summary detailing the driver's characteristics and risk of involvement in accidents, as well as recommended individual training rather than the normal blanket approach.
